Press Centre

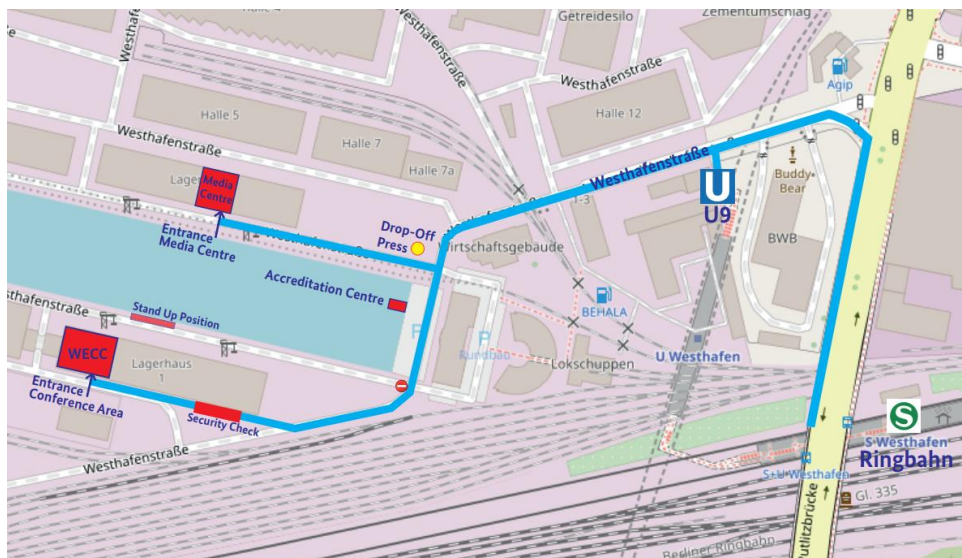

The Press Centre is also the **meeting point** for the transfer to the individual photo/film and press sessions at the WECC venue. **There is no individual access to the press positions.** Journalists arriving after the security check times shown will not be admitted.



Arrival

No parking is available on site. We recommend that you travel to the venue by tram or underground (U-Bahn)/rapid transit train (S-Bahn). There will be a drop off point on site near the Press Centre. The purpose of this is to briefly allow equipment to be loaded/unloaded and for people to embark/disembark. Vehicles may not be parked here either.



COVID-19 hygiene concept

All participants must be able to present a rapid test that was carried out at a certified testing centre. The test may **not** be older than 24 hrs. There will be no testing capacity on site. In addition, the use of an FFP2 mask is recommended. If you have any cold symptoms, we would ask you to refrain from attending.
